

Before you begin

Read through the case study and its associated learning outcomes.

As you work through sections of the hands on activities use the links to *Aligning Assessment to Learning* and *Understanding Assessment* to gain an understanding of the important elements.

Activity 1: Levels of Learning

After relevant reading and reflection, make a decision about the level of learning and domain of each of the outcomes in the case study.

Record these in the relevant section of the Assessment Strategy Brief

For each outcome select a teaching/learning activity from your completed evaluation that meets the learning approach of the outcome, record these in the relevant sections of the strategy brief

Activity 2: Aligning Learning

For each outcome select an appropriate teaching/learning activity that meets the learning approach of the outcome, for instance a lecture may produce surface learning, while a case study may encourage deeper learning, record your selections in the relevant sections of the strategy brief

Activity 3: Aligning Assessment

For each outcome select an appropriate assessment activity that meets the learning approach of the outcome, for instance a multiple choice test may assess surface learning, record your selections in the relevant sections of the strategy brief

Activity 3: Aligning Feedback

For each outcome consider the level of learning implied and decide on the type and method of feedback that will be required to underpin and further learning, can this be generic or must it be more individualised, record these in the relevant sections of the strategy brief

Activity 5: Assessment Matrix

Using the analysis outcomes complete the Face to Face section of the assessment matrix. The online section will be completed after the second stage – online evaluation
